

## **BLUE TONGUE REGULATIONS FROM 1<sup>st</sup> JUNE TO 9<sup>th</sup> SEPTEMBER 2026**

### **CATTLE**

Cattle vaccinated with Bultavo-3 vaccine can move unrestricted if they have been vaccinated; with 21 days elapsing since completion of the primary course.

Where the primary course was completed over 12 months prior to movement, a vaccine booster is required.

Non-vaccinated cattle resident in England and Wales require a negative pre-movement test within 7 days prior to any move to Scotland.

Cattle moving from a Scottish holding to a sale or show in England or Wales can return to Scotland within 4 days without further testing (a post-movement test is recommended but not obligatory).

**Cattle from Scotland can be sold at Longtown Mart and may return to Scotland from the mart (either to a purchaser or to their home of origin) without restriction.**

### **SHEEP**

Sheep moving from a Scottish holding to a sale or show in England and Wales can return to Scotland within 4 days, without further testing.

All sheep resident in England and Wales require a negative pre-movement test within 7 days prior to any move to Scotland.

**Sheep can be sold at Longtown Mart and may return to Scotland from the mart (either to a purchaser or to their home of origin) without restriction.**
